Students electing to major in Russian Studies must also complete a second major in Fulbright College. Selection of the second major should be in consultation with the area studies advisor/director. Freshmen and sophomores considering this program are advised to begin their study of Russian as early as possible.

Requirements for a Major in Russian Studies:

□ RSST 4003 Russian Studies Colloquium

Students must complete the equivalent of a third year of Russian language training such as **RUSS 3013** and **RUSS 3023**.

In addition to the language requirement and the Colloquium, **18 hours** in courses with specific content related to Russian studies, or in individualized courses under faculty participating in the program.

The following conditions apply to the selection of Russian studies electives: Courses must be selected from at least 3 separate depts., a maximum of 9 hours may be submitted from any one dept., and a maximum of 9 hours may be submitted from courses taken in the student's major dept.
